Pastor's Corner



Have you made your New Year's resolutions? I've kind of given up on them; they seem to fizzle out each year as I lose interest or momentum, or both. But there is something to be said about starting off a new year with a fresh look and fresh attitude about life.

As I contemplated resolutions this year, I realized that if you change just one letter in the word resolution, you end up with revolution. And I think God's resolution for us is just that: revolution. Complete change from what is to what could be.

We serve a God who is nothing less than revolutionary. *"I'm doing something new; it's happening. Can't you see it?"* [Isaiah 43:19] *Put on a new self, created after the likeness of God.*

[Ephesians 4:24] *The Word is constantly bearing fruit and increasing.* [Colossians 1:6]

Jesus set the revolutionary example for us: interacting with tax collectors and prostitutes, placing children in a prominent position, conversing alone with a woman who was neither a relation nor even a Jew, occupying a cross rather than a jeweled throne. *"My kingdom is not of this world."* [John 18:36] In other words, what we expect from this world—success measured as wealth and fame, retribution and vengeance, continued injustice in order to prop up the status quo—is not the world God wants for us.

God wants us to measure success in terms of service to others, to offer mercy rather than vengeance, to pursue justice even when it means we give up some of our own privilege. This is revolutionary.

So are we going to make the same old resolutions this year? Or are we going to be revolutionaries and follow in the way of Jesus? Are we going to lose interest in our resolutions? Or are we going to be on fire for revolutionary proclamation of the Good News of God in Jesus Christ? God is already bringing about revolutionary resolutions on behalf of all creation. [Revelation 21:5] Will we follow God's lead and make some revolutionary resolutions of our own?

Council Candidates Needed



Treasurer's Report

To keep everyone informed of the financial status of Zion Lutheran, we will be starting a monthly Treasurer's Report in the newsletter. The overall purpose is to be transparent about how Zion is building a culture of generosity and being a steward (manager) of God's gracious provision in order to fuel Jesus' ministry.



Through November 30, 2022, **income** received to the Current (general offering) was **\$140,216.58**. This money is used to provide financial support for the ministry budget expenses such as faith formation, evangelism, worship, staff salaries, property, etc. This amount does not include the 10% benevolence. Thank you to everyone who is going above and beyond to financially support the mission and ministry of Zion.

The ministry **expenditures** are **\$141,173.66** as of November 30, 2022. Our expense budget is \$182,685.29. We are currently at 77.3% of expenses. Thank you to the ministry teams for being good stewards.

As of November 30, 2022, the church's **undesignated cash balance** is \$26,336.44. This is money that is not specifically designated to a specific purpose, such as utilities, mortgage debt reduction, lawn mowing, GermanFest, etc. The undesignated cash balance is like our savings account or reserve fund when our

expenses are more than our income. This can be quickly depleted if actual income doesn't match expenses.

As of November 30, 2022, our **benevolences (ministry to the world)** are:

As of November 30, 2022, the balance available in the **GermanFest/Crisis Bank** account is \$13,551.18
