# Pastor's Corner



Dear friends in Christ,
You'll be reading this as I vacation on Dauphin
Island, Alabama. What a joy it is to listen to the
unceasing sound of the ocean as the waves
crest and fall and spread over the beach. I can't
seem to get Psalm 8 out of my mind: When I
look at your heavens, the work of your fingers,

the moon and the stars that you have established; what are human beings that you are mindful of them, mortals that you care for them? O Lord, our Sovereign, how majestic is your name in all the earth!

The waves make me think of God's grace and love. They never cease coming, one upon another. Sometimes crashing upon us, sometimes sneaking up on us. They don't play favorites; if you're near them, you're going to get wet. # Lenten Challenge Earthquake Relief

Two powerful earthquakes have hit Turkey and significantly impacted neighboring Syria. The first was a magnitude 7.8 earthquake in south central Turkey, followed hours later by a magnitude 7.5 quake in the southeastern part of the country. The two quakes have devastated Turkey and Syria, collapsing thousands of buildings and damaging infrastructure. Syria is also dealing with an ongoing civil war. During the Lenten season Zion will have a Noisy Offering Sunday services. The funds collected will be sent to ELCA Lutheran Disaster Response.

#### Treasurer's Report

To keep everyone informed of the financial status of Zion Lutheran, we include a monthly Treasurer's Report in the newsletter. The overall purpose is to be transparent about how Zion is building a culture of generosity and being a steward (manager) of God's gracious provision in order to fuel Jesus' ministry.



Through January 31, 2023 **income** received to the Current (general offering) was **\$16,849.30**. This money is used to provide financial support for the ministry budget expenses such as faith formation, evangelism, worship, staff salaries, property, etc. This amount does not include the 10% benevolence. Thank you to everyone who is going above and beyond to financially support the mission and ministry of Zion.

The ministry **expenditures** were **\$12,733.40** as of January 31, 2023. Our expense budget is \$238,486.82. We currently are at 5.4% of expenses. Thank you to the ministry teams for being good stewards.

As of January 31, 2023, the church's **undesignated cash balance** is \$24,434.39. This is money that is not specifically designated to a specific purpose, such as utilities, mortgage debt reduction, lawn mowing, GermanFest, etc. The undesignated cash balance is like our savings account or reserve fund when our expenses are more than our income. This can be quickly depleted if actual income doesn't match expenses.
