

Pastor's Corner



I'm a cute penguin.

At a previous congregation, we decided to participate in the local community celebration parade. We dressed up as penguins, decorated an enormous trailer with a winter theme,

handed out fliers and freeze pops and walrus toys and pens, had lots of signage, and traveled the Colby Cheese Days parade route with invitation and fellowship.

Did we get more visitors to our congregation? More members? More 'butts in the seats? More money in the plate? I can't say that we saw any results we could measure by counting anything. We left all that to the Holy Spirit as it moved in the people we waved at and smiled at and spoke to. We'll never know how the Spirit might have made connections because we got silly and smiled at people we didn't know.

Jesus told his disciples to go and make more disciples. That wasn't an easy task in a time when travel, information, and influence moved at a snail's pace. But it's not an easy task now, either, when everything moves at the speed of light. So just like those first disciples, we have to take risks. It might mean talking to someone you don't know, learning to make sauerkraut for Germanfest, volunteering to be a friend to someone who speaks a different language, giving more to church or other non-profit than you think you're able to give, or standing up against a bully (whether a person or a government). It might even mean (gasp!) talking about Jesus or inviting someone to worship or bible study or fellowship.

Our job is to proclaim what God has done for us in Christ Jesus, and then stand back and let the Spirit work. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in

Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth. [Acts 1:8, NIV] So, go and make disciples. Be a witness to how God is changing your life and growing your faith. And if that means wearing a penguin suit on a warm summer day and waving your flippers off, then, by all means, go for it!



Treasurer's Report

To keep everyone informed of the financial status of Zion Lutheran, we include a monthly Treasurer's Report in the newsletter. The overall purpose is to be transparent about how Zion is building a culture of generosity and being a steward (manager) of God's gracious provision in order to fuel Jesus'

ministry.

Through March 31, 2023 income received to the Current (general offering) was \$40,857.10. This money is used to provide financial support for the ministry budget expenses such as faith formation, evangelism, worship, staff salaries, property, etc. This amount does not include the 10% benevolence.



Thank you to everyone who is going above and beyond to financially support the mission and ministry of Zion.

The ministry **expenditures** were **\$44,864.92** as of March 31, 2023. Our expense budget is \$238,486.82. We currently are at 18.9% of expenses. Thank you to the ministry teams for being good stewards.

As of March 31, 2023, the church's **undesignated cash balance** is \$15,959.35. This is money that is not specifically designated to a specific purpose, such as utilities, mortgage debt reduction, lawn mowing, GermanFest, etc. The undesignated cash balance is like our savings account or reserve fund when our expenses are more than our income. This can be quickly depleted if actual income doesn't match expenses.

As of March 31, 2023, our **benevolences (ministry to the world)** were:

As of March 31, 2023, the balance available in the **GermanFest/Crisis Bank** account is \$11,556.28.
