#### Pastor's Corner



Dear Friends in Christ,

Wow, Lent starts early this year! I feel like we just finished the twelve days of Christmas, welcomed a new year, and celebrated Epiphany. Now here we are staring Ash Wednesday full in

the face (February 14). So, how many of you are going to give up something for Lent? Why?

Ask yourself that question: "Why am I giving up something for Lent?" Well, here are some possible reasons:

- 1. Because that's what people do.
- 2. It reminds us of what Christ gave up for us.
- 3. It teaches me to be more generous to others.
- 4. It helps me get started on leaving bad habits behind.
- 5. I want to do the right thing to get into heaven.

None of these reasons are bad, but I have one more question for you to answer:

Does giving up something for Lent draw you deeper into Christ and into God's vision of the Kingdom?

That's the biggest question of all because if giving up something or even adding something to our daily routine (bible reading, prayer, setting aside money for the poor) doesn't make us more closely aligned with God's vision, it's not worth it. So, what is God's vision? Kindness, compassion, mercy, forgiveness, and lavish welcome of all with no restrictions. We welcome all to Christ's table

of mercy during worship; we must welcome all into—and with—our whole lives. So go ahead, choose your Lenten discipline, but look for the connections between what you are giving up and how it pulls you toward deeper faith in God. May the Holy Spirit deepen your faith during this penitential season.



#### **Operation Christmas**

Sweet Dreamz is a non-profit organization located in Spencer Wisconsin that provides comfort items to children ages newborn to 17 years who come from a home of substance abuse as they make their way into foster care things these children cannot take with them during this very hard transition. When a child is removed from a home, they are not allowed to take anything with

them because it is contaminated. Sweet Dreamz serves 45 counties throughout WI including Marathon and Wood. Sweet Dreamz provides these things to give them hope for a brighter future. Each child receives a homemade pillowcase filled with a blanket, a stuffed animal, pajamas, and a book – all specific to their age and size. Currently, the greatest need is for age and size 2T to 10/12. Pillowcases must be homemade. Sweet Dreamz currently has volunteers making pillowcases but will accept any homemade pillowcases and

blankets or quilts.


