Pastor's Corner



Dear Friends in Christ,

Christ is risen! Alleluia!

He is risen indeed! Alleluia!

I write this article before we have even reached Palm Sunday in the

liturgical calendar.

It's so easy for us to say that Christ is risen, but can we imagine what it was really like for the disciples when it happened? Good Friday was not good; it had no *wink, wink, nudge, nudge* element to it. There was no gathering of family and friends to look forward to. There was no Easter egg hunt or baskets of candy or pictures with the Easter bunny at the mall. There was no annual worship participation surrounded by choir and organ and brass instruments and joy. There was only fear.

- The women ran from the tomb and said nothing to anyone, for they were afraid. [Mark 16:8]
- The disciples were in a closed-up, locked place because they thought they would be next. [John 20:19]
- When Jesus appeared after the resurrection, they were afraid because they thought he was a ghost. [Luke 24:37]

Let me repeat: They. Were. Afraid.

So why do we see them as heroes, as people who followed Jesus no matter what? Because Jesus came and stood among them when they were most afraid.

Because Jesus breathed on them his Holy Spirit and said he would be with them always. Their ability to disciple came about because they finally understood that Jesus was in their midst, even when things looked the worst for them. It was only because Jesus was with them that they were able to overcome their fears and grief and get on with the tasks he set for them: make disciples, baptize, teach, love one another.

This is why I can write the phrase, Christ is risen, before we have even reached the 2024 commemoration of that terrible Friday. This is why I have been able to say Alleluia! even during some of the darkest times of my life. It has nothing to do with me, and everything to do with Jesus standing among the ashes of my life and saying, "I will never leave you." May you, too, know the presence of our risen Lord among the ashes of your life, and may your fear always be changed to joy and thanksgiving through his love.]





On behalf of the Faith Formation Team, I am letting our valued congregation members know that we are looking out for the best interest of our young people here in Zion. In a continued effort to always make sure we are being responsible we are in the process of updating our policies and procedures for the prevention of Child Abuse. We are going to be doing Background checks on anyone who is volunteering here at Zion, our goal is to not deter volunteers but to enhance our trust in our congregation and those involved in all the activities we do for our young people here at Zion.

We will be using an electronic-based company called "Lifeway" through Clear Investigative Advantage out of Frisco Texas.

The process is very confidential, and the background check will be handled by Kathy in the office. Each background check will cost \$9.00 per volunteer, and we will be doing checks every other year.

The cost of background checks will be paid out of the Faith Formation Budget. As a Faith Formation Team, we are always looking to provide the safest, most comfortable environment for our youth here at Zion.


