### Pastor's Corner



Dear Friends in Christ,

You all know how much I love our annual vacation to Dauphin Island, Alabama, but did you know that I also love the long drive down there and back?

My enjoyment of these long hours is found in the time cooped up with my husband. We do lots of catching up, of course, since our work schedules don't line up very well during normal times. We also listen to audio books and discuss what we're hearing.

The last couple trips, we've been obsessed with Scientology, and this year we tackled A Billion Years by Mike Rinder, a former top executive with the organization. A main premise of Scientology is that a person can perfect their faith by following an exacting schedule of classes and counseling sessions.

Mistakes allegedly are severely punished, and it seems that fear is the motivator behind this entire "faith" system.

Through each of the stories related by Rinder in his book, what bothered me was how fearful each person was of messing up. They spent thousands of dollars on courses and counseling sessions to advance to the next level, but the anxiety they carried about making mistakes was devastating to hear and instilled deep sadness in me. As disciples of Jesus, we know we are forgiven. Make no mistake, however; Jesus doesn't give us a free pass on our errors. He expects us to learn from them, to turn from them, and to discern from them a better path. The difference is that he stands among us and with us; he

forgives our mistakes; he heals us from our failures and leads us forward in his way. There is true freedom in Jesus' love; freedom to stop doing our own math and let God do it God's way. We are therefore completely free to love and serve without keeping track of what it costs or what merits we earn.

That makes me happy!



Any age can play, so let's have some fun with this!


## Tuesday morning Bible Study

We are going to be doing Background checks on anyone who is volunteering here at Zion, our goal is to not deter volunteers but to enhance our trust in our congregation and those involved in all the activities we do for our young people here at Zion. We will be using an electronic-based company called "Lifeway" through Clear Investigative Advantage out of Frisco Texas. The process is very confidential, and the background check will be handled by Kathy in the office. Each background check will cost \$9.00 per volunteer, and we will be doing checks every other year. As a Faith Formation Team, we are always looking to provide the safest, most comfortable environment for our youth here at Zion.
