PASTOR'S CORNER



Dear friends in Christ,

I had a different pastor's letter ready to go for this newsletter when I received word that our friends over at Emmanuel Lutheran in Longwood experienced a fire last night. The congregation is in shock, but trusting in the Lord for future direction and current

comfort.

It made me think about the Jonah sermons I've been preaching for a couple weeks. Jonah has been running away from God's direction and ends up in a most unlikely and probably scary and uncomfortable place—the belly of a great fish. Yet while he's there, he prays as if God has already rescued him. He trusts that that the Lord will deliver him even if the delivery means he has some difficult actions to take. The Ninevites are then given a message that their city will be overthrown in forty days. Even though they're given nothing else but that message of doom, they trust that God may yet have a change of mind. This will mean difficult decisions about change, but they rely on the Lord to deliver them anyway.

The congregation in Longwood is trusting the Lord right now as to what their future holds. They know there will be difficult and costly decisions ahead, and new ways of doing things will need to be explored. And still they trust.

After all, where God is involved, being overthrown (or having a wrench thrown into the works) means something new is about to happen. We will keep you posted on how you and our congregation can help.

In the meantime, a fund has been set up for the congregation as they discern how to proceed. Please keep them in your prayers.

Update as of 5:40pm, 7/23: A fund has been set up at Forward Bank in Withee to take donations for Emmanuel's fire recovery efforts. We don't know exactly what is before us and we appreciate the community's support in helping with unanticipated/uncovered expenses.



The remaining \$2,000 will be used for additional local needs once more information has been received from the organizations. The bulk of the estate funds will remain available to Zion for future infrastructure repairs. It has been a privilege for this committee to demonstrate God's love in this way, and we are proud of our congregation for recognizing the importance of the biblical injunction to tithe. We pray for additional blessings on all who have received a gift, and for newly inspired generosity on the part of Stratford community members.


