PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Friends in Christ,

When I was little, my family made a big deal out of Valentine's Day. My brother and I made homemade cards for everyone, Dad brought Mom roses, and Mom made sugar cookies with I Love You written on them with icing. Dad's cookie was always written in Latin: *ego amo te*. Yes, I come from a long line of nerds.

It's fun to celebrate Valentine's Day. It's romantic to leave the world behind and concentrate on that special someone. I have a sneaking suspicion, however, that Valentine's Day is every day for God. And it's not just about that special someone; it's about that special everyone. Scripture shows us how important love is to God; depending on the translation used, love is mentioned between 300 and 350 times. But Jesus shows us what love is according to God. After all, Jesus said, "If you have seen me, you have seen the Father." [John 14:9] And if God is love [1 John 4:8], then we only have to look at how Jesus lived and how he died to understand what love really is.

Jesus showed us that love stands up for those who are at the bottom of the pile. That love seeks out the outcast and befriends them. That love can become angry when faith is turned into moneymaking. That love is steadfast and true. That love involves deep humility and sacrifice. That love is resilient and patient and turns the other cheek.

This is the kind of love that is of God, and it is the love God celebrates every day with us. Love that died on a cross and was resurrected because of pure love itself. There is no charge, no need to prove we are worthy of love; there is only God's love simply because God is love. And rather than leave the world behind to concentrate on someone special, God tells us to wade right back into that world and love everyone.

The children of Zion will be collecting a noisy offering on the first that they decide on as a


